

Privacy Policy for Rupert Lowe MP

Rupert Lowe MP is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect your personal data. Please read this policy carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal information.

1. Data Controller

The data controller responsible for the processing of your personal data is Rupert Lowe MP.

3. Categories of Personal Data Collected

We may collect and process the following categories of personal data: name, address, email. Personal data is collected directly from constituents as required for our work.

4. Reasons for Collection and Use of Personal Data

Personal data is collected and used for the following purposes:

- To communicate with constituents regarding Rupert Lowe MP's work.
- To provide information on local events and activities.

5. Lawful Basis for Processing Personal Data

The lawful basis for processing your personal data includes:

- **Public Task:** Processing is necessary for tasks performed by Rupert Lowe MP as part of his duties to support or promote democratic engagement.
- **Legitimate Interests:** Processing is necessary for the legitimate interests of Rupert Lowe MP or a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject.
- **Consent:** In cases where explicit consent is required, such as for newsletters or surveys.

For special category data, the basis for processing will typically be:

- **Explicit Consent:** Processing with the explicit consent of the individual.

6. International Data Transfers

We do not routinely transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA). However, some third-party services we use may store data outside the UK. We ensure that such services have appropriate contracts and safeguards in place to protect your data.

8. Data Retention Policy

We will retain personal data for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. Typically, personal data is held for up to two years after the end of a parliamentary term.

9. Rights of Individuals

Under data protection law, you have the following rights:

- The right to be informed about the collection and use of your personal data.
- The right to access your personal data.
- The right to rectification of any inaccurate or incomplete data.
- The right to erasure of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to restrict or object to the processing of your personal data.
- The right to data portability.
- The right to object to the processing of your data for specific purposes, such as direct marketing.

10. Right to Withdraw Consent
